Indifference to which we have every thing to hope, and nothing from intimidation? Why teach her the value of the possession by our eagerness to seize it? Or what former question, either of commercial inter course, or territorial right, had been so compromised, that we should repent or be weary of negotiating? Since there are two way of acquiring Territory, by force, and by treaty, let us adhere to that in which we have been most successful; for though, we meet resistance, we may retrace out steps, we cannot easily allay the irritation these Resolutions must produce, or explain their offensive terms.
