Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Go. vernor, Council and Assembly, That from and after the passing of this ' Act, it shall not be lawful for any person to use any Net for the purpose of taking Bass in the said River Richibucto, or any of its branches. unless the Meshes of such Net shall be over five inches square, under the penalty of five pounds for each and every offence, to be recovered bef re any Justice of the Peace for the County wherein such River or Branches shall be situate, upon the oath of one or more credible wirness, or wirnesses, and to be levied together with the costs of such conviction by warrant of discress upon the goods and chattels of such offender, and for want of such goods and chattels the off nder to be committed to the County Gaol, by warrant under the hand and seal of such Justice, for the term of ten days, unless such fine and costs shall be sooner paid; all which penalties when recovered to be paid to the Overseers of the Poor, for the Parish where the offence shall be committed, for the support of the Poor thereof.
