The Canal works new under centract proceed with every expedition. The present month has been particularly favorable for the various operations of cutting and embanking, dressing of slopes, and masonry ; but owing to the great depth of excavation upon No. 2 Section, the result of labour to the Contractor will not be found so great as bitkerso, although the actual force employed has encreased by an average of 35 workmen.

Operations upon Section No. 3, have for seven working days been proceeded with.

The bottom of Lake Charles, near to Reeve's mill race, will require to be depressed 5 feet 6 inches, for an extent of 278 feet lineal, to avoid a narrow and circuitous passage, through which the original soundings were taken.


