III. To entitle any claimant to the premium for the best, or the second best fat Ox, it is further required, that he not only exhibit a statement of the mode of fattening, but prove that the Animal has been kept within this Province for at least twelve months prior to the day of exhibition.

IV. Claimants for premiums for the best, and second best together at least six months before the day of exhibition.

V. The quantity and quality of the Butter, for which premaiums may be claimed, and the number of Cows from which the same shall have been made, together with the mode mant, confirmed by two respectable neighbours.

VI. Persons claiming preminums upon imported Animals, shall engage to keep the same within the Province.

VII. No Animal for which one premium shall frave been awarded to any owner, shall be considered a subject for any further premium of the Society, except it be for qualities different from those for which the first premium was awarded.

No premiums will be awarded to any person who shall not be a Member of the Central Society, or of some one of the County Agricultural Societies, in this Province.

Any attempts to obtain premiums by unfair practices, will be punished by a forfeiture of the premium, should it be ing been taken by virtue of an Execution issued out of the Supreme awarded before a discovery, and will also preclude the offen- Court at the suit of Messrs, James Taylor, Sen., & Co der from competing for premiums in future. Premiums not demanded within six months after they are awarded, shall be considered as having been generously given in aid of the funds of the Society.

Note. - The Premium for the best pair of draught Mares or Geldings, will not be awarded unless it shall be proved that they are well broke, and have been driven together, previously to the day of exhibition.
