Example.—A person aged 20 next birth-day by the payment of £1, may secure one pound per week when-ever incapacitated. Should such occur within one year from date of Policy or the same party by the aunual payment of £1 2 6, for five years may secure the like amount when ever incapacitated, should such occur within FIVE years from date of policy. Or by the payment of £1 5 annually for seven years secure the same amount, should incapacity occur within Seven years from date of policy.
