MAIL CONVEYANCE From Halifax to Guysboro,

Via the Great Eastern Road.

ERSONS desirous of entering into a Contract for the conveyance of Her Majesty's Mails from HALIFAX to GUYSBORO', via the Great Eastern Road, passing through and serving the settlements of Middle and Upper Musquodoboit, Glenely, (St. Mary) and Country Harbour, once a week each way, are requested to send in SEALED TENDERS addresse. to the Postmaster General, stating the sum per annum in Halifax (urrency, for which they would agree to

perform the service. The onditions of the Contract are that the Mais shall be conveyed on such days and at such hours from either end of the route, as may from time to time be pointed out by the Post Master General, the rate of speed to be not less than Five Miles an hour, and the Mails to be conveyed by Horse and Waggon or on Horseback.

A notice of Three Months to be given on either side to terminate the Contract,

Security will be required for the due and faithful performance of the Service.
