WINDSOR, N. S., TO ST. JOHN, N. B.

The Steamer Emperor runs between Windsor, N. S., and St. John, N. B., every Wednesday and Saturday.

The Emperor also passes from St. John to Digby and back, on Mondays and Thursdays.

The R. M. Steamship Lady Head plies between Quebec, C. E., and Pictou, N. S., calling at intermediate ports.

LICENSED CAB DRIVERS may charge for half a mile, 6d.; one mile, 1s.; a mile and a half, 1s. 3d.; 2 miles, 1s. 6d.; 3 miles, 2s.
