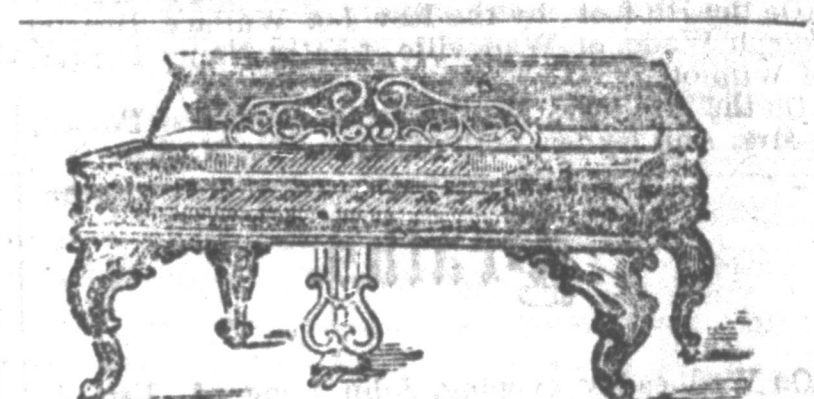
BAZAAR AT SPRINGFIELD.

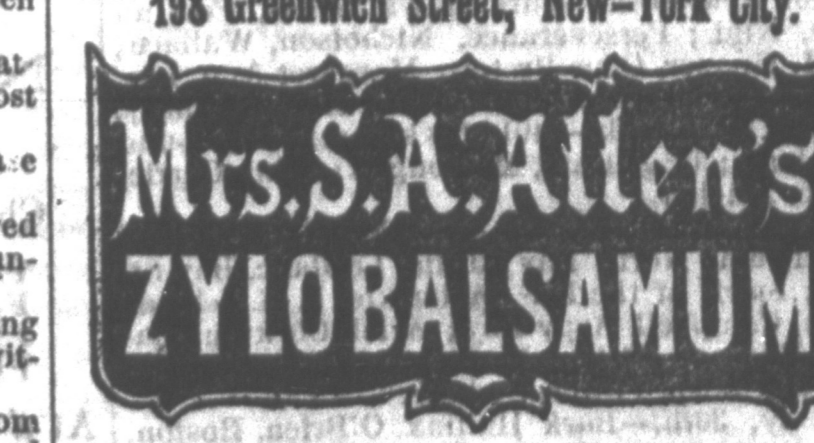
