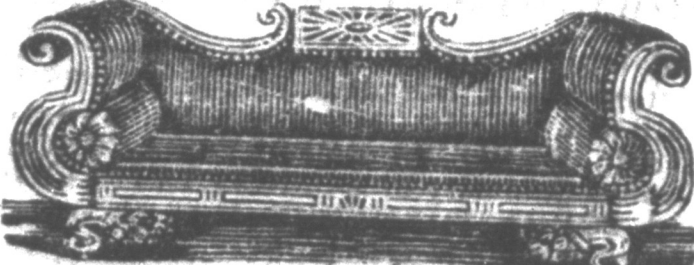
Table with columns: MAIN LINE, WINDSOR BRANCH. Rows show departure and arrival times for Halifax and Windsor.
