The Light house on Little Hope Island, on the south east coast of this Prevince, in lat 43deg. 48min. 31sec. N., Ion. 64deg. 47min. 16sec. W.; is situated nearly in the centre of this Island, and exhibits a Revolving Red Light, elevated 40 feet above high water, attaining its greatest brilliancy every minute. The Lantern is placed on the top of the Keeper's dwelling, which is painted white. Height from base of dwelling to top of lantern, 31 feet.
