LIQUOR LICENCES IN HALIFAX CITY.-At a late meeting of the City Council, it was resolved to fix the scale of license duty as follows :- Hotel, Saloon, Inn or Confectionary \$100; shop \$100, and tavern, in which nothing but liquor should be sold, \$50.


