The Chemistry of Furniture.

Young housekeepers do not always understand the theory of the chemical and mechanical action of different substances on articles of furniture.

Acids act on marble. Marble is itself composed of lime; that is, it is a compound of carbonic acid and lime.

All varnished or polished surfaces of wood on the other hand, while not injured usually by acids, are attacked by alcohol.

If any alcoholic substance comes upon such a surface, whether it be alcohol itself as used for lamps, or spirits of any kind, or even wine, which contains but a small percentage of alcohol, the varnish is attacked.

Oil will not attack either marble or varnished surfaces, and will not do any injury except to naked wood or other porous substances which admit it into the pores.

The practical lesson to be learned from this is, that housekeepers must take care in dealing with furniture to keep water away from everything soluble in water.

Road-making in England.

The roads in St. James's Park, London, are being formed by the aid of a powerful steam roller. The ground is first picked up, then covered with broken granite and a top-dressing of sand.

How unlike this is the process of making streets and roads in this vicinity! A street is picked up a little, a few loads of broken stone are dumped down and levelled off.
