of Canada, ten cents per pound. 5th. Every permit shall be valid only when the form is supplied by the Department of Inland Revenue and signed by the person issuing it. And every such permit shall be delivered to and retsined by the importer or grower of the Tobacco as evidence that the Tobacco to which it relates was lawfully removed, and the said Permit shall be produced by him whenever de-manded by any Officer of Inland Revenue for the pur-pose of taking an account thereof,

6. All persons issuing Licenses or Permits under these Regulations or who receive any duty on Raw Leaf Tobacco entered for consumption, shall transmit all money so received to the Receiver General at least one once in each week or oftener should the amount collected in one week exceed fifty dollars, and they shall account to the Department of Inland Revenue in such manner, at such times and in such form as may be from time to time determined by Departmental Regulations in that behalf.

7. All persons licensed to deal in Raw Leaf Tobacto shall keep an account of all that they receive or sell or otherwise dispose of in such form as may be prescribed by Departmental Regulations. June 17.
