TEA CULTURE IN CALIFORNIA.

California boasts that she is soon not only to be independent of the outside world as regards tea, but will have plenty to spare for her less fortunate neighbors.

USE OF LEMONS.

When persons are feverish and thirsty beyond what is natural, indicated in some cases by a metallic taste in the mouth, especially after drinking water, or by a whitish appearance of the greatest part of the tongue, one of the best "coolers," internal or external, is to take a lemon.

A productive cow is mentioned by the Waterloo, Quebec, Advertiser. Mr. Larivee of Brome, has a cow eight years old, which gives fifty one pounds of milk per day.

USEFUL FACTS.—Toads are the best protection for cabbage against lice. Plants, when drooping, are revived by a few grains of camphor.

Sulphur is valuable in preserving grapes, etc., from insects. Lard never spoils if cooked enough in trying out.

In feeding corn sixty pounds ground goes as far as one hundred pounds in the kernel; and if the meal be cooked, the saving will be still greater; there is no food we give stock which is nearly so important to cook as Indian corn.

Turnips of small size have double the nutritious matter that large ones have. Their fattening properties are greater than beets, though the latter are best for milk.

To CURE SCRATCHES IN HORSES, wash their legs with warm soap-suds, and then with beef or fish brine. Two or three applications will cure the worst case.

Money expended in drying land by draining pays the farmer the largest interest he ever receives.

KINDNESS TO MILCH COWS.

Mr. Willard says, in the Utica Herald: We have often wondered why men of a naturally saving disposition, who would be shocked to see a pint of milk spilled in the milk-house, should allow quarts and gallons to be lost in the bad management of the herd in the stable, kicking cows with heavy boots, striking with stools and keeping the animals in a constant strain of nervous excitement and fear.
