CELERY FOR WINTER.

This useful vegetable is often destroyed during winter, in consequence of water or frost reaching the tops, if set upright for winter use.

To prevent this, you should invert the plants, viz: by placing the tops down; and this plan has been found to succeed admirably.

The length of the ridge should be determined by the number of the plants to be packed. If you have six hundred plants to be packed, make the ridge long enough to pack two hundred heads, and four hundred must be packed on top in two tiers.

FATTENING HOGS.

As the time is drawing near for penning hogs for the next year's supply of meat, we advise our readers to procure both charcoal and mineral coal.

TO FRY FISH.
