

cream goes into the churn. By far too many keep the milk and cream at the same temperature or at least in the same cellar or vault. Either the cream or mik will suffer, one being too warm or the other too cold."

TOADS IN GARDENS .--- In a lecture on " Insect Enemies," lately delivered by Mr. Treat before the Vineland Agricultural and Horticultural Society, the usefulness of toads in gardens was forcibly pointed out. The lecturer advised his hearers to carry all the toads they find into the garden, as they devour immense quantities of insects. A toad will swallow the largest specimen of a .tomato worm, although sometimes he will have a hard time of it.

TO FEEL THE PULSE OF A HORSE .- This is best felt where the artery passes over the edge of the jaw-bone. To find it, apply the fingers to the angle of the jaw bone, and slowly pass them down to where a notch in the bone may be felt; the artery passes along this notch, where the throbbing will be perceptible. It is generally situated about three inches from the angle of the bone. In the horse the beat of the pulse are from 32 to 38 times a minute, in a state of health.

An ingenious mechanic in Philadelphia has invented a pile-driver, which by the use of a very small charge of percussion powder, a driving · force about eight times that of a falling weight, is given, while the weight at the same time is driven up the rack by the explosion ; where it is caught and held ready for another fall and explosion.

A woman at North Leverett, Mass., has made eight hundred palm leaf hats within the year. besides doing all her housework.


