

immediate, prosecution of her long cherished designs on the East.

Mr. Lowe and Mr. Cardwell have positively arrayed themselves against war on the present issue.

In view of the early convocation of Parliament, Mr. Gladstone hesitated to commit himself for or against war on the present provocation.

Russia appeals to all friendly powers to note the fact that a Congress is "impracticable in the present state of the principal European powers, and that Russia expressly disclaims any hostile intentions or a desire to disregard any of the provisions of the treaty of Paris other than those which were originally admitted to be unjust and oppressive."

The Italian Government has declined to join in the diplomatic move against Russia.

SPAIN.—The Cortes have elected the Duke of Aosta, King of Spain by a vote of 191 against 120.

Despatches from Madrid say that the committee appointed by the Constituent Cortes to confer with the Duke of Aosta have set out for Italy for that purpose.

ITALY.—A Florence despatch says that the Quirinal has been entered by the Italian authorities. The keys could not be obtained, and they picked the lock. Everything found within was seized. The seizure of the Palace has called forth severe comment from a part of the clerical journals, and these have all been seized confiscated.

IRELAND.—Cork, Nov. 15.—A great demonstration of sympathy for the Pope was made here to-day. The meeting was presided over by the Bishop of the Diocese, and addressed by members of Parliament. Resolutions expressing personal sympathy for the Holy Father, lamenting the obstructions of his temporal power as detrimental to peace in Europe, and in favor of memorializing Her Majesty's Government on the subject were adopted.

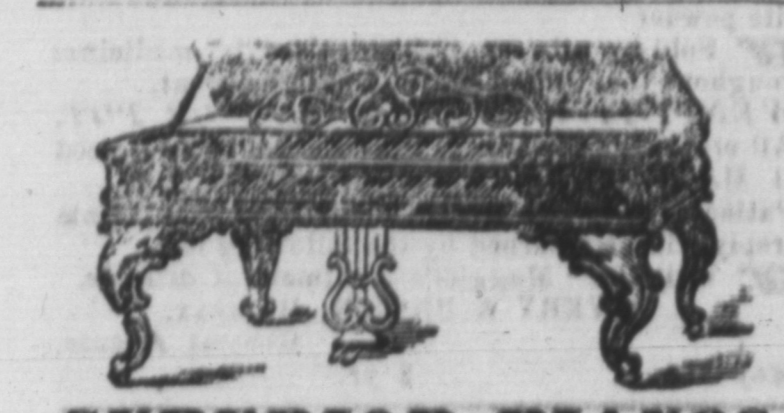

ON the recommendation of the Hon. the Minister of Customs, and under authority given by the 8th Section of the Act 31st Vic., Cap. 6, intituled: "An Act respecting the Customs," His Excellency has been pleased to order, and it is hereby ordered, that the Port of Owen Sound, in the County of Grey, and the Province of Ontario, shall be and the same is hereby erected into and constituted a Warehousing Port, within the meaning of that Act.
