TURKEY.—Thirty-two Turks, charged with the murder of the Montenegrins in Alabama, have been sentenced to twenty years imprisonment.

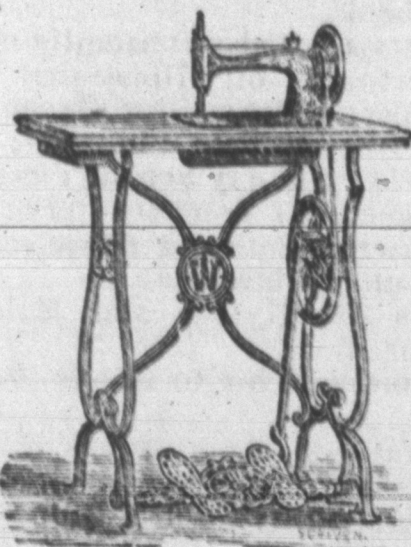

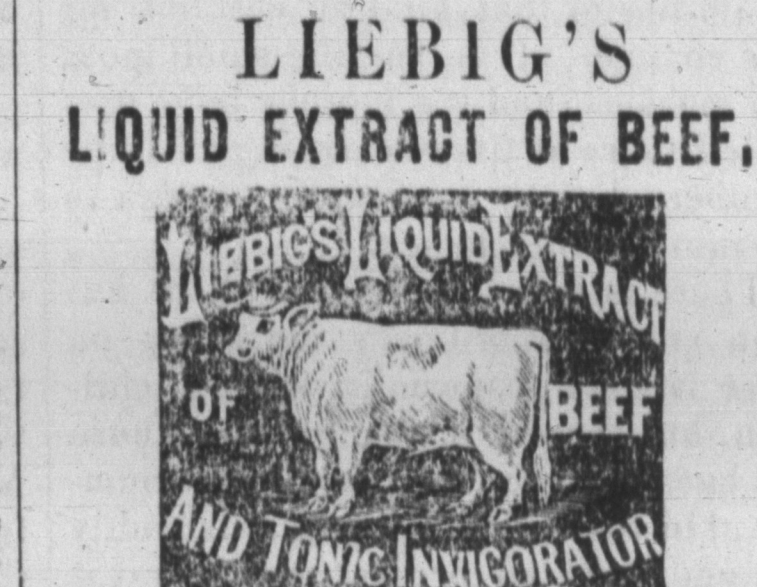
