THE TIDES.—The column of the Moon's Southings gives the time of high water at Parrishore, Cornwallis, Horton, Hantsport, Windsor, Newport, and Truro.

High water at Pictou and Cape Tormentine, 2 hours and 11 minutes later than at Halifax. At Annapolis, St. John, N. B., and Portland Maine, 3 hours and 25 minutes later, and at St. John's, Newfoundland, 30 minutes earlier, than at Halifax.

FOR THE LENGTH OF THE DAY.—Add 12 hours to the time of the sun's setting, and from the sum subtract the time of rising.

Agricultural.

SOILS AND FERTILIZERS.—Turfy loam, being rich in decomposing vegetable fiber, forms a soil acceptable to almost all families of plants, forming, as it were, the staple or ground work to which other soils or ingredients may be added.

When this is carted into the soil yard it should be stacked up in the form of a ridge, and might, with advantage, be thatched with some literary material, so as to prevent it from becoming saturated with cold rains during winter, or from desiccated during dry summer weather.

COMMON MISTAKES.—What a common mistake it is, amongst even some of our most intelligent men, to select low, sheltered, warm places if possible, whereon to lay out their orchards, quite forgetful of the fact that by so doing they are laying their fruit and other trees all the more liable to the ravages of frost.

TERRIBLE DESTRUCTION BY GRASSHOPPERS.—Dr. Witt, Nebraska, July 30. Last Saturday the thermometer was 112 all day. The next morning grasshoppers commenced to fall and have continued ever since.

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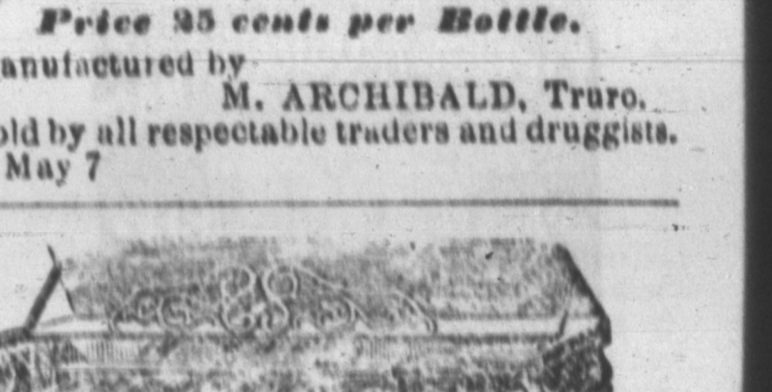
