The Halifax Reporter was suspended on Saturday evening. A smaller sheet called the New Times and Reporter appeared on Monday evening, published by the Phoenix Publishing Company with J. C. Crosskill, the former proprietor of the Evening Reporter, as Manager. No. 1 of the new paper is a lively promising sheet.

Sir Charles Tupper, Mr. Schreiber, Mr. Pottinger, and several other railway officials arrived in town on Friday last. They were met at the Depot by a number of gentlemen belonging to the Evangelical Alliance for the purpose of remonstrating against the employment of the railway and its officials on the Sabbath, especially for the conveyance of shows, circuses and troupes of theatricals, as the "Pinafore" company were lately. The Witness says: "Sir Charles Tupper met the delegates in the most frank, cordial and satisfactory manner. He stated that he was as much surprised as any one to learn that special trains had been given on Sundays for Circus or Theatre Companies. The granting of a special train to the Pinafore Company to travel over so much of the road last Sunday was entirely unjustifiable. He strongly disapproved of it, and the like should not occur again. He assured the delegates that it would be the earnest and constant endeavour of the Government to reduce Sunday work and travel on the Railway to a minimum. Messrs. Schreiber, Pottinger and Taylor were present, and Sir Charles repeated to them the emphatic instruction that everything possible was to be done to avoid Sunday labour on the road. He referred to the necessities created by the cattle trade, and the special mail trains connecting with steamers arriving here in winter. These cases were unavoidable. While it might be impossible to stop the Sunday morning train it would soon be so arranged as to arrive in Halifax at or before 9 A. M. There would be no effort spared to reduce Sunday work to the lowest point possible without deranging the business of the country. He and the officers in charge of the road would be most thankful for any practical suggestions in regard to the matter.—The delegation were gratified with the assurance that there should be no more special trains for Circus Companies, &c., and with the emphatic declarations of Sir Charles that the department should do all in their power to meet the views of the strictest observer of the Sabbath. The delegation, after thanking Sir Charles for his courteous reception, withdrew, feeling satisfied, we believe, that all that can be done will be done for the "better observance of the Lord's Day."

At the meeting of the City Council on Wednesday last, a letter from the Secretary of the Sugar Refinery Company was read, asking for a resolution passed embodying an offer made by the city last May to grant a free supply of water for a sugar refinery, and such other concessions as the Council felt disposed to make. The site, he said, would probably be selected within a few days. A committee was appointed to confer with the Company and ascertain what quantity of water they would require. Aldermen Mackintosh, Murray, Connolly, Chipman, Graham and Story were appointed such committee. Another meeting was held on Friday

when it was stated that the Sugar Refinery would probably require 200,000 gallons of water per day. The Committee recommended that a free supply be granted for ten years. The report was finally adopted.

The City School Board met on Friday last. Mr. A. Archibald was transferred from the Richmond to the Albro Street School at a salary of \$950 per annum. Other changes were made which it was said would save the city \$1,790 per annum. Dr. Curren, Supervisor, submitted a report by which it appears that exclusive of the 55 boys attending the High School, we have in Halifax, 4,871 pupils taught in our schools, by a staff of 103 teachers. This gives a general average of 47 to each teacher employed. With such a staff of teachers the Schools surely ought to be well taught. A letter was read from Mr. Peter O'Hearn, complaining of the condition of St. Patrick's School, and charging the Principal with incapacity. It was moved by Mr. Aokhurst that Mr. O'Hearn's letter be not received, inasmuch as the letter was couched in discourteous language and reflected on some of the members of the Board. The motion was seconded by Mr. Brookfield and passed.

Lieutenant Harvey, while on duty on board H. M. S. Belerophon on Monday suddenly fell, and before he could be carried to his room he was dead. Deceased was a well known and popular young officer. He was subject to heart disease. The Londonderry Steel Company's blast furnace was lighted up on Thursday last, and is doing finely. The Colchester County Supreme Court was in a State of some excitement last week over the trial of a liquor dealer for perjury. Another case of a similar character is pending on the result of this one. Dartmouth is giving encouragement to its citizens to plant shade trees in front of their houses by remitting a portion of taxes, 25 cents for each tree, to all who will plant and protect them in the streets. The Annapolis Supreme Court was held last week. Judge James presided. At the opening some complimentary remarks passed between the bench and the bar especially with reference to his Lordship, who spent his early days in that county. As there was a clear criminal docket a pair of white gloves was presented to and accepted by the judge. There is a large number of civil cases to be tried.

HANTS COUNTY took prizes at the recent Exhibition in Halifax amounting to \$1,123.50. The Windsor election resulted as follows:— E. W. Dimock, Esq., for Warden, A. P. Shand, Esq., Councillor for Ward 1, J. W. Webb, Esq., Councillor for Ward 2, and Shubael Dimock, Esq., Councillor for Ward 3, all without opposition. Rev. J. F.
