should be reduced to one member for each County, save and excepting the counties of Halifax and Pictou, which should have each two representives, making the total represention in the Assembly twenty members, instead of thirty-eight, as at present constituted.

And further Resolved, (3.) That the indemnity to the members of the Legislature should be reduced twenty five per cent. from the indemnity paid during the last Parliament in this Province.

And further Resolved, (4.) That, in the opinion of this House, the salary of all officers and employees of the Legislature should be hereafter reduced twenty-five per cent from the sum paid thereto during the last session of Parliament.

And finally Resolved, (5.) That the salaries of the members of Government holding departmental offices and all persons employed in the civil service in this Province, under the the centrel of the Local Government, be likewise reduced twenty-five per cent. from the amount now paid.

The principal speakers for abolition of the Council were Hon. Mr. Creelman, Hon. J. S. McDonald, Hon. Dr. Parker, Hon. Mr. Black.

The Council came to a division on Friday afternoon when there appeared for the original resolution, Hon. Messrs. Parker, Cameron, McDonald, Black, Mc-Kinnon and Creelman, 6.

Against it-Hon. Messrs. Oakes, Mc-Curdy, Butler, Charles Dickie, J. B. Dickie, Baker, Cochran, Morrison, Tupper, Fraser, Franchville, Boudrot and the President, 13.

The amendment was then voted upon, but not as a whole. Each of the five resolutions or clauses were put separately : On the 1st the vote stood, For 12, Against 7, the same as the previous decision except that Hon. Mr. Fraser voted with

2 against-Messrs Cameron and Creel-On the third the vote was 18 to 1-

Hon. Dr. Cameron. On the fourth there were 10 to 9

voting with the minority. The fifth clause was carried by the same majority.
