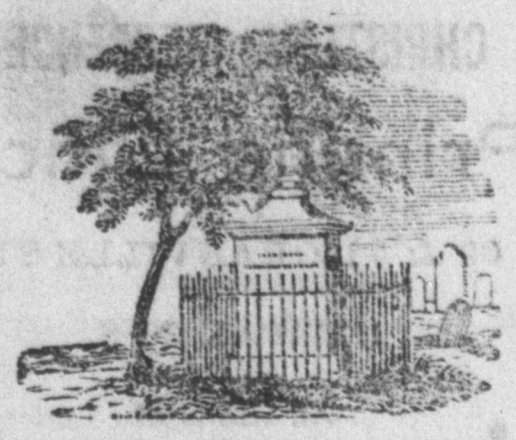

The Messenger Almanac.

Table with columns: Day, SUN, MOON, High Tide. Rows for Last Quarter, New Moon, First Quarter, Full Moon.

THE TIDES. - The column of the Moon's Southing gives the time of high water at Pictou, Cornwallis, Horton, Hantsport, Windsor, Newport, and Cape Tormentine, 2 hours and 11 minutes LATER than at Halifax.

FOR THE LENGTH OF THE DAY. - Add 12 hours to the time of the sun's setting, and from the sum subtract the time of rising. FOR THE LENGTH OF THE NIGHT. - Subtract the time of the sun's setting, from 12 hours and to the remainder add the time of rising next morning.
