Almanac table showing moon phases and other astronomical data for November 1882.

THE TIDES.—The column of the Moon's Southings gives the time of high water at Parraboro, Cornwallis, Horton, Hantaport, Windsor, Newport, and Truro.

FOR THE LENGTH OF THE DAY.—Add 15 hours to the time of the sun's setting, and from the sum subtract the time of rising. Subtract the time of the sun's setting, from 12 hours and to the remainder add the time of rising next morning.
