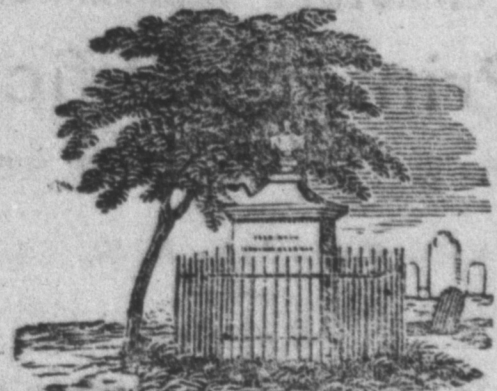

INTERCOLONIAL RAILWAY, SUMMER ARRANGEMENT.

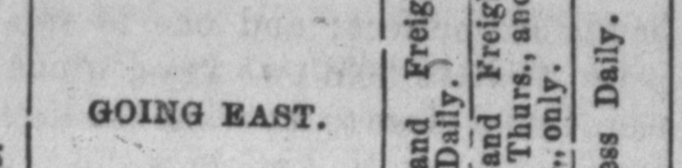
