Of course this may cost more than to go via Fredericton, but it is the quickest way to the Grounds from up river. Or, any who wish can go on to St. John and take the "Olivette' or "Hampstead" there, as the train from Woodstock arrives at St. John about 1.15 ploring us to come and teach them and the steamers do not leave St. John

> Persons having mileage tickets will be able to go via Westfield and the steamer as cheaply as by F'ton.

> Again, on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays the steamer "Springfield" passes Westfield about 1 or 1.15 p. m.and arrives at the Camp Grounds at 3 p. m., so that persons going from Woodstock and wishing to get to Camp Ground quickly, can do so on the days mentioned. The steamboat landing is about quarter of a mile from Westfield Station. And Westfield Station is about 14 miles above St. John on the C. P. R.
