It is, therefore, poor policy to employ hard, metal instruments to treat the cuticle at the base to treat the cuticle at the base of the nails. The best course, and here the huge hat of the is to dip a cotton-tipped orange stick into cuticle remover, and work gently around the base of each nail with that. The process will soften the cuticle and enable it to be pushed back merely with gentle pressure. And the danger of having the nails marred by white spots will be greatly lessened.
