

HOCKEY CONTEST

In the Maritime Hockey League ("Big Four") there are four teams entered—Halifax "Wolverines", Charlottetown "Abbies," Moncton "Hawks" and Saint John "Beavers." They are scheduled to play each week until the end of the season—February 20.

In the chart shown herewith there are twelve squares representing the teams in the six games that will be played during the week beginning December 17. A prize of \$500.00 (as well as smaller prizes) is offered each week to every person who can correctly estimate the goals and the periods in which they will be scored in any five games designated.

Estimate and mark in the actual goals you think will be scored in the periods. Leave other periods blank. Entries are judged only on the goals scored.
