Charlotte County Find Expected To Yield 135,000 Tons.

Rich deposits of diatomite have recently been discovered in New Brunswick, four areas being located in Charlotte County, according to the Natural Resources Department of the Canadian National Railways. Diatomite is formed from shells of diatoms which inhabit salt and fresh water and when the plant dies the shell falls to the bottom of the sea, lake or river. About 4,000 tons of diatomite is consumed annually in Canada, 60 per cent. in the sugar refineries for filtering purposes. It is estimated that the new deposits will yield 135,000 tons of diatomite.
