It was revealed for the first time to a small group of aviation executives and experts at Baltimore. No. 5 was built for trans-Pacific use by the Pan-Amer-

ican Airways. It is a gleaming giant of chrome metal, measuring 90 feet in length, and 24 feet high, and it has a wing span of 130 feet. It weighs 23,100 pounds, empty. It will take the air, with its full crew, fifty passengers, and a capacity load of freight, weighing 51,000 pounds.


