In the deep water section the younger people are cavorting like frogs. At the other end of the pool the older folks are just wading.

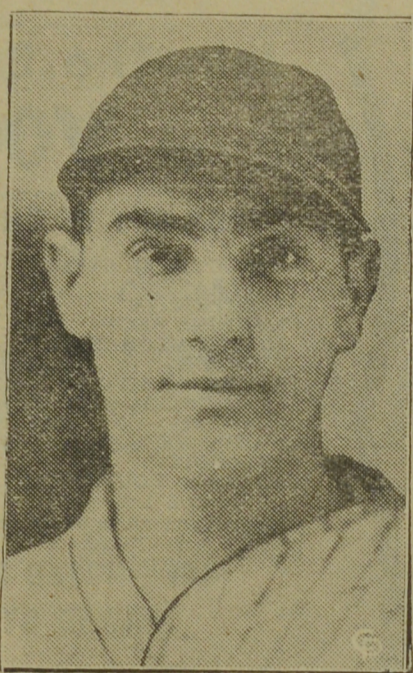

Moves Up Again

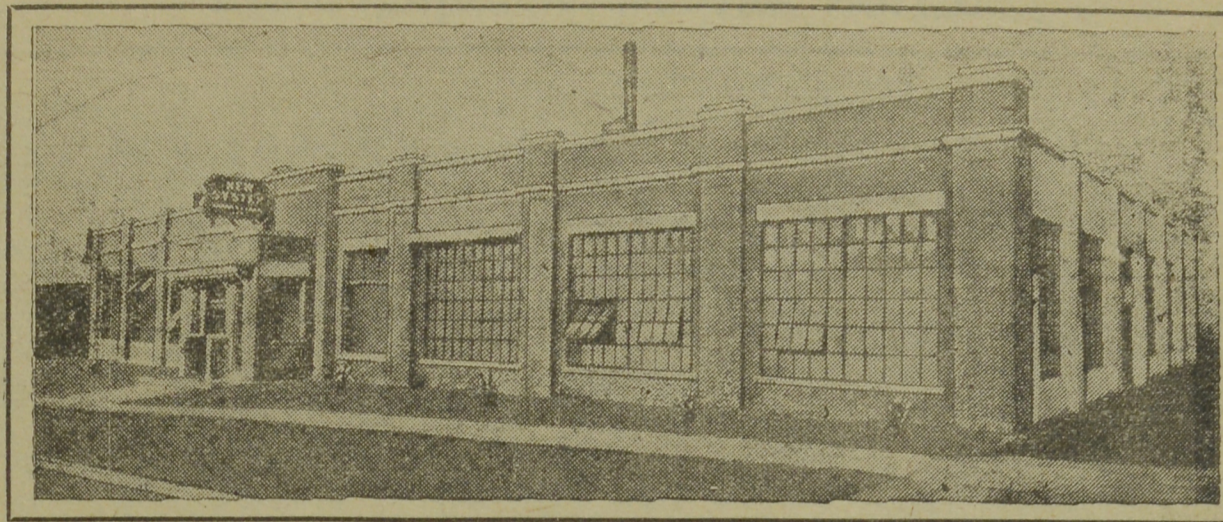

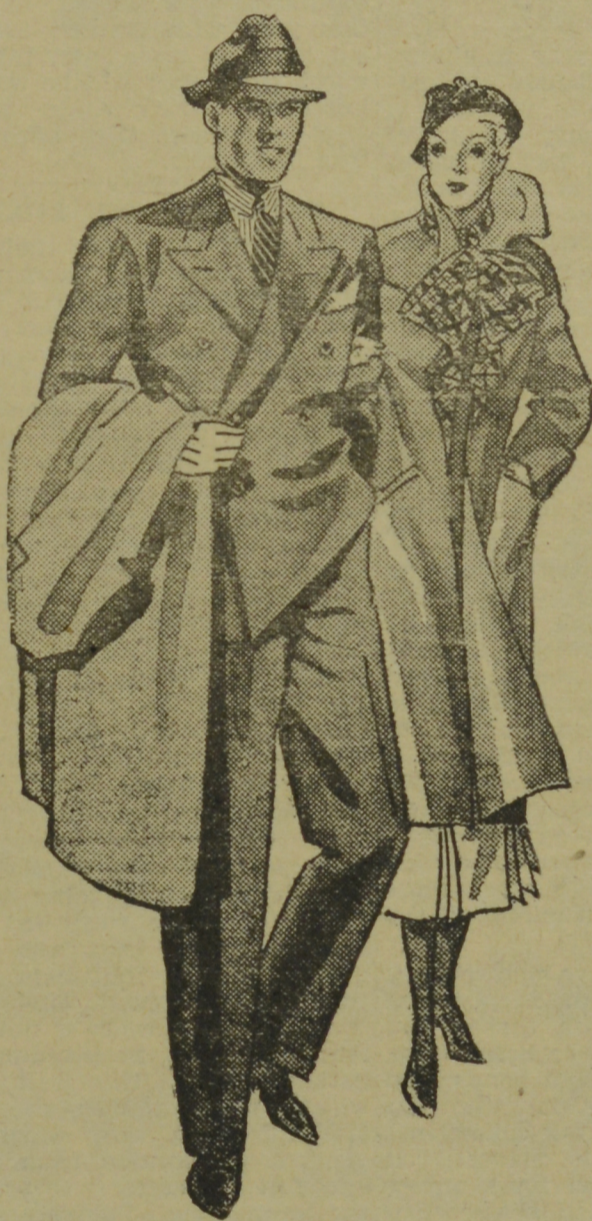
