DuBerrier "Air Corps" For Ethiopia Was Just Jolly Cocktail Party Idea

Monte Carlo.—Speculation on the possible Italo-Ethiopian scrap is an amusement all can play at providing one doesn't tell the whole world one's going to take an active part on either side.

This has been impressed very formally on Hal du Berrier, 29-year-old American stunt aviator by the secret police of Monaco.

Considerable attention was given by American papers recently to Du Berrier's statement that he intended to raise a small fleet of aeroplanes with international pilots, reminiscent of the Lafayette Escadrille, for Ethiopia.

His idea of an expedition to aid Haile Selassie took shape in a swanky Monte Carlo night club while cocktails flowed freely.

The American aviator was entertaining a party of friends, among whom were an English cartoonist, a Czechoslovakian sculptor and a score of more or less prominent representatives of the international colony from Monteparanasse.

Du Berrier mentioned that he was an aviator and then added that he might raise a small corps of volunteers to fight for the "Lion of Judah." All his friends took him seriously, drank enthusiastically to his health and swore allegiance.

Armand Deleau, chief of the Monaco police, called on Du Berrier as soon as word of this got out and notified him that he would have to "watch his step" or get out of Monte Carlo, as his projected aviation corps might cause trouble with Italy. Correspondents sent the news sizzling through the cables.

"The police are still watching me closely," Du Berrier said recently. "They think I am recruiting volunteers for the Negus, which is not true."

As result of the publicity given his statement, he has received thousands of letters from persons wishing to join the Ethiopian army, many from the United States, he says.

His "air corps" is still just another idea.
