

Nearly A Million Barrels Of Apples Used In Plants

Record Amount Used For the Manufacture of By-Products.

Kentville.—Breaking all previous records, both in production and price, three-quarters of a million barrels of Nova Scotia apples have this season been absorbed by fruit by-product plants in the Annapolis Valley and South Shore.

That over 700,000 barrels of Nova Scotia apples have passed through the by-product plants in the Annapolis Valley and South Shore is the statement of Cecil Eidt, superintendent in charge of fruit by-products at the Dominion Experimental Station. The previous high was an even 700,000 barrels chalked up in the record three million barrel commercial crop last season.

This season the Nova Scotia apple commercial yield totals on the final check up two and a quarter million barrels. This is the third highest in the history of the industry which started back in 1604.

But the establishment of new records in regard to by-products does not end with production. Ever present, there is that most vital question—what does the grower receive?

According to Mr. Eidt the grower is much better off in this class of fruit than for the past five years.

For instance, the opening price of 15 cents finally was raised to 45 cents. This season, however, the minimum price was 40 cents with a maximum top of half a dollar. That was for low grade fruit. For domestics barred by the Dominion Marketing Board, the price was 80 to 85 cents per barrel.

One Annapolis Valley plant alone will this season manufacture some 10,000 more cases of evaporated apples in one gallon containers than the entire output from this province last season when the grand total was 50,000 cases. There is no question but that if Nova Scotia growers had to depend on the United Kingdom markets this season they would have been "out of luck." Evidence to this effect is shown by the fact that another new all-time record was chalked up when approximately 1,400 cars, or roughly 300,000 barrels, were shipped to Quebec and Ontario markets. This as compared with 300 cars the previous shipping season.

Total shipment over the Dominion Atlantic to Halifax was 6,500 cars, as compared with 8,300 cars in the 1934 all-time record. However, on the grand totals of domestic and export shipments, the D.A.R. is less than 1,000 barrels short, despite the fact that more than half a million barrels was exported last season.

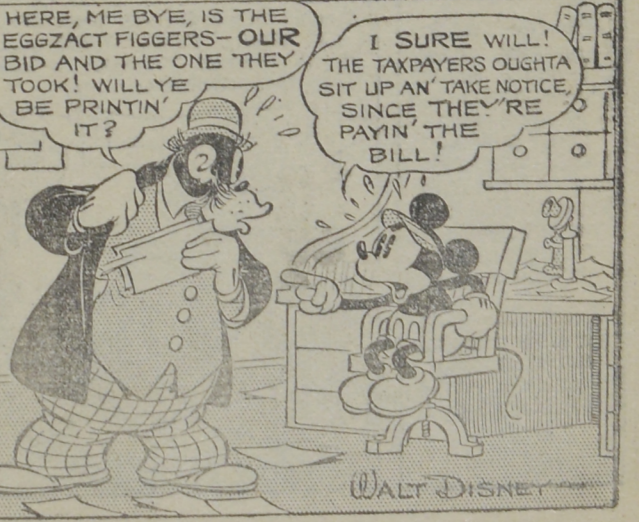
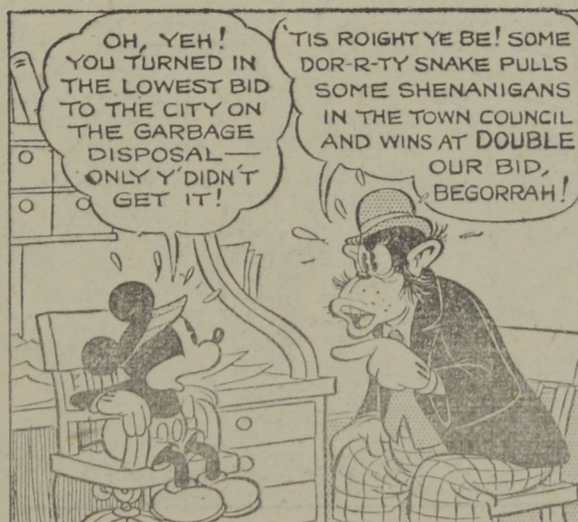
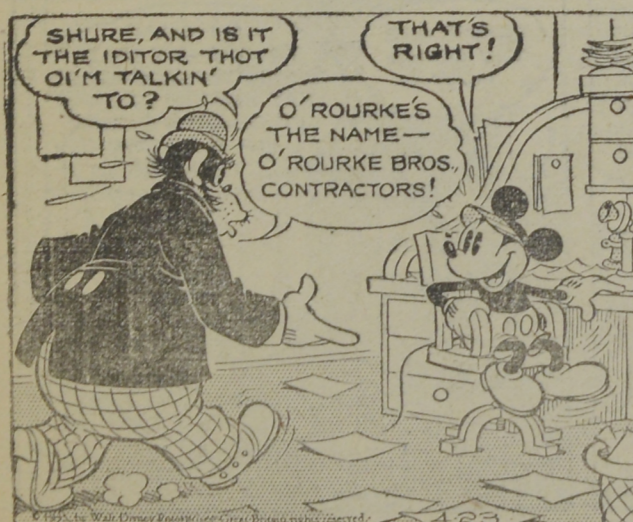
