Sixty-First Annual Gathering in Nova Scotia.

New Glasgow.—The 61st annual convention of the Nova Scotia Pharmaceutical Society opened in the Norfolk Hotel last Tuesday at 10.30 a.m., with a council meeting presided over by Mayor P. W. Holdsworth, attended by the president, Vice-president J. Fraser Robertson; Secretary G. A. Burbridge, Halifax; Vernon Worth, Halifax; F. Colquhoun, North Sydney; H. Madden, Liverpool; F. Chittick, J. D. Walsh, J. H. C. Murdock, Henry Curtis and A. A. Thompson, Halifax.

At 2.00 o'clock the society convened for the first session and a welcome was extended by Mayor Clarence Miller and by J. Fraser Robertson and D. R. McLeod for the Pictou County Druggists' Association. It was revealed that there were seven practising members who had been with the Society for 50 years or more.

The treasurer's report showed a surplus and the Board of Examiners reported one graduate, T. R. Cooke, Sydney, passed as a pharmacy chemist. 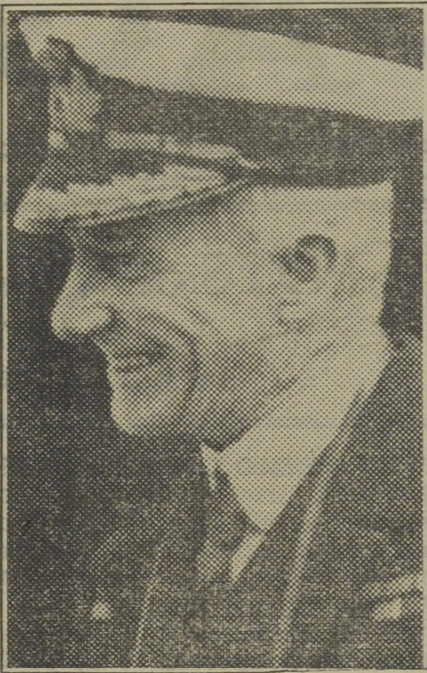

Sunny Brae Will Pave A Section of Cemetery Road

Providing, However, That the Assistance of Government Available.

At a joint meeting of the taxpayers and members of the Town Council of Sunny Brae, matters pertaining to the proposal to construct a hard-surface road from Hall's Creek bridge to the entrance of Elmwood cemetery were discussed. After lengthy debate on the subject it was decided that this work would be commenced providing the Government would assist in paying a certain percentage of the cost. His Worship Mayor Prince was appointed as a committee of one to interview Hon. D. A. Stewart, Minister of Public Works, with the view of ascertaining if the Government is prepared to render financial assistance in this proposed project.

During the meeting members of the council and several citizens expressed their views on the matter, all of whom were unanimous in the opinion that the work should be done if at all possible. Mr. Stephen, of the Stephen Construction Company, Saint John, also addressed the meeting and outlined the construction program and stated that it would take about two months to complete the job.

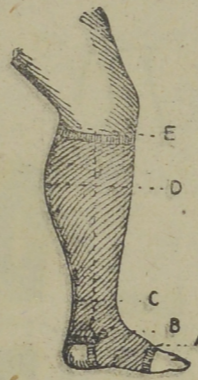

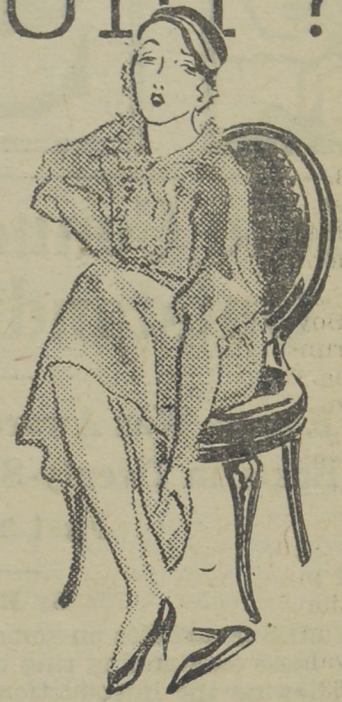

Court Rules That Town Re-Elect Its Council Members

Election By Acclamation in St. George Is Found Illegal.

Fredericton, N.B.—Chief Justice J. B. M. Baxter ruled in the New Brunswick Appeal Court recently, that Mayor Louis Rubin and five aldermen in his council at St. George should resign and that another election should be run in the town. The action followed a complaint that six officials held office illegally because the latest time for receiving nominations April 12 last had been fixed at 5.00 p.m. instead of 6.00 o'clock as provided by law. Nomination papers filed by seven other candidates at 5.45 p.m. were rejected, it was claimed, and the first slate of nominees was declared elected by acclamation April 16.

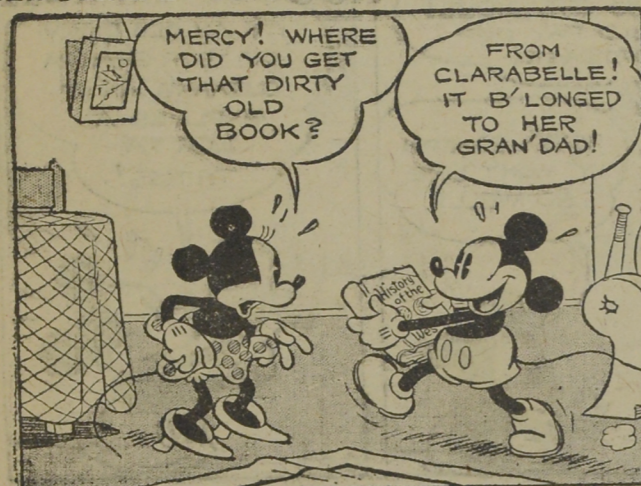

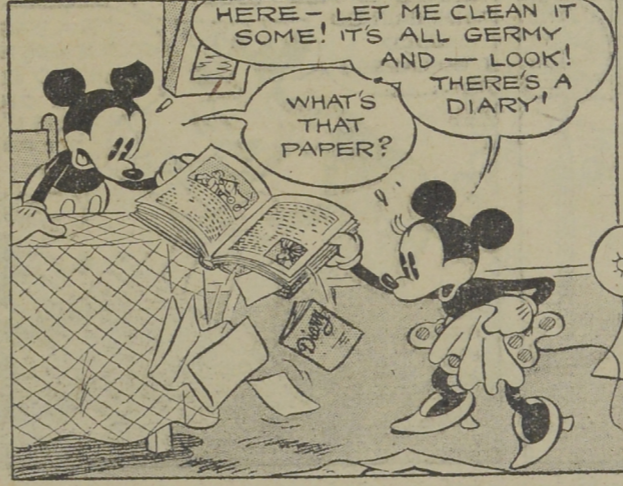

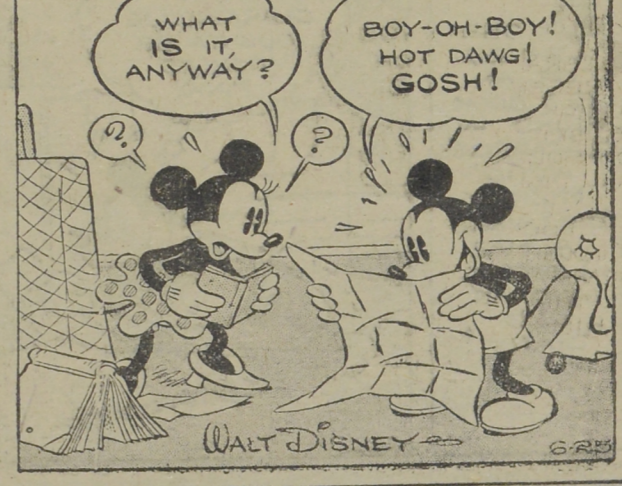
