

Net Revenue Down On C. N. R. System During April

Monthly Statement of Operation and Several Comparisons.

Montreal, Que.—After payment of operating expenses the Canadian National Railways for the month of April, 1936, had net revenue amounting to \$1,455,306, according to the monthly statement of operating revenues, operating expenses and net revenue for the all-inclusive system issued at headquarters.

Operating revenues for the month of April showed an increase of \$1,038,347, while operating expenses increased \$1,110,036, a decrease in net revenue of \$71,689 as compared with the corresponding month of last year.

For the four-months period ending April 30, 1936, operating revenues showed an increase of \$2,947,382, while operating expenses increased by \$3,424,028. Net revenue for the period amounted to \$1,532,048, a decrease of \$476,646 from the similar period of last year. The summaries follow:

Province's Pork Products Can Be Raised At Home—Taylor

New Brunswick Government to Encourage Hog Raising For Domestic Market—Urges Home-Grown Grain For Feed.

Fredericton, N.B. — To make New Brunswick self-dependent in the production and purchase of bacon hog products is the desire of Hon. A. C. Taylor, Minister of Agriculture.

"It is estimated," he says, "that the products of from 30,000 to 50,000 hogs are annually imported and this represents a considerable drain of money, which if diverted to our own farmers, should materially improve their income. This Province also imports annually large quantities of grain and grain products and there should be associated with this hog production policy a crop producing plan which would enable the farmers to grow the greater portion of the feed necessary for the production of these hogs. By this means the full benefit of the policy will remain with the New Brunswick farmers."

Details of the two-fold plan have been worked out. The fol-

lowing ration tables, compiled by the Livestock Division of the Provincial Department of Agriculture, are suggested for the best results in feeding:

RATION 1

Young Pigs 2 to 8 Weeks of Age—
Sifted ground oats or ground hullless oats and white middlings equal parts. Skim milk 2½ to 3 pounds per pound of grain or 4 per cent fish meal.

Growing Pigs 8 Weeks to 100 pounds Live Weight—Ground oats, 300 pounds; ground wheat, 200 pounds; ground barley, 500 pounds; minerals, 20 pounds; fish meal, 70 to 100 pounds.

Note: Skim milk at the rate of 1½ to 2 pounds of skim milk to 1 pound of grain may replace fish meal in the above rations. Supply water in addition.

Pwllheli.—Dr. Lloyd Hughes, of Bottwog, near here, who was summoned at dawn recently to attend a five-year-old girl, seriously ill on Bardsey Island, off the Caernarvonshire coast, motor-ed ten miles through a snow-storm and crossed the four-mile treacherous sound during a gale in an open motorboat.

Beacon flares—the only means of communication with the mainland for the 40 inhabitants—were noticed on the island mountain early in the morning, and Aberdaron villagers summoned Dr. Hughes by telephone.
