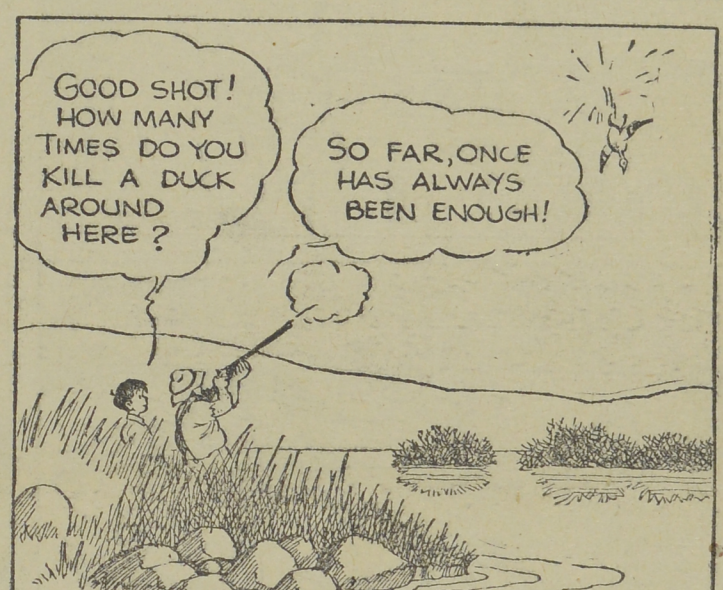

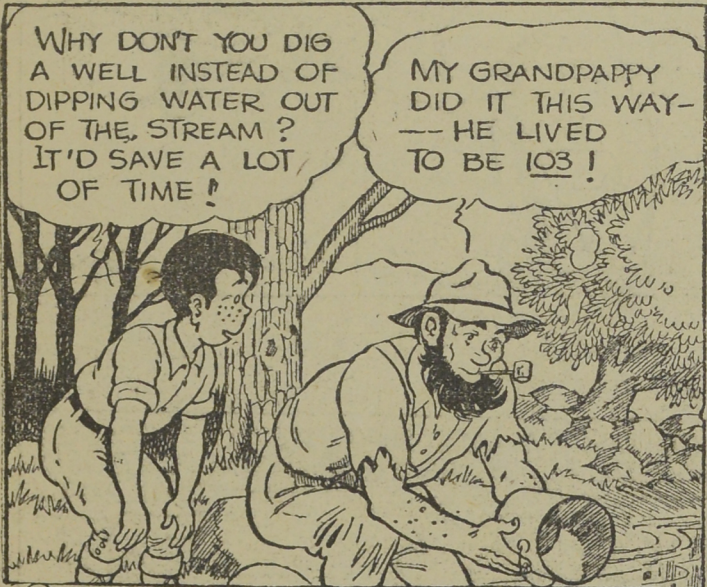
WELL, A SHOTGUN SCATTERS SHOT IN A BIGGER AREA!

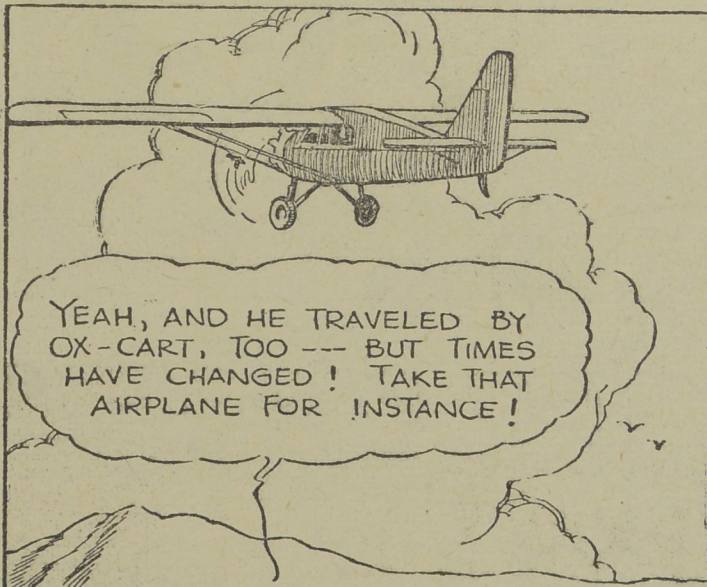
GOOD SHOT! HOW MANY TIMES DO YOU KILL A DUCK AROUND HERE?

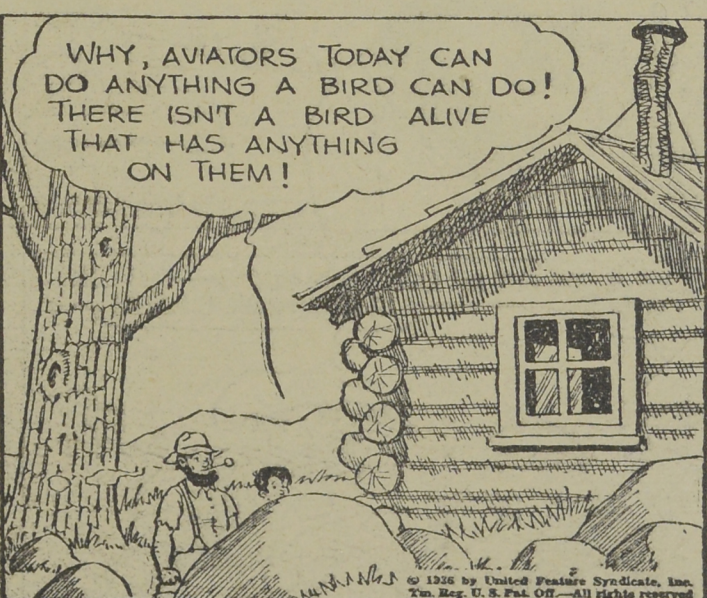
