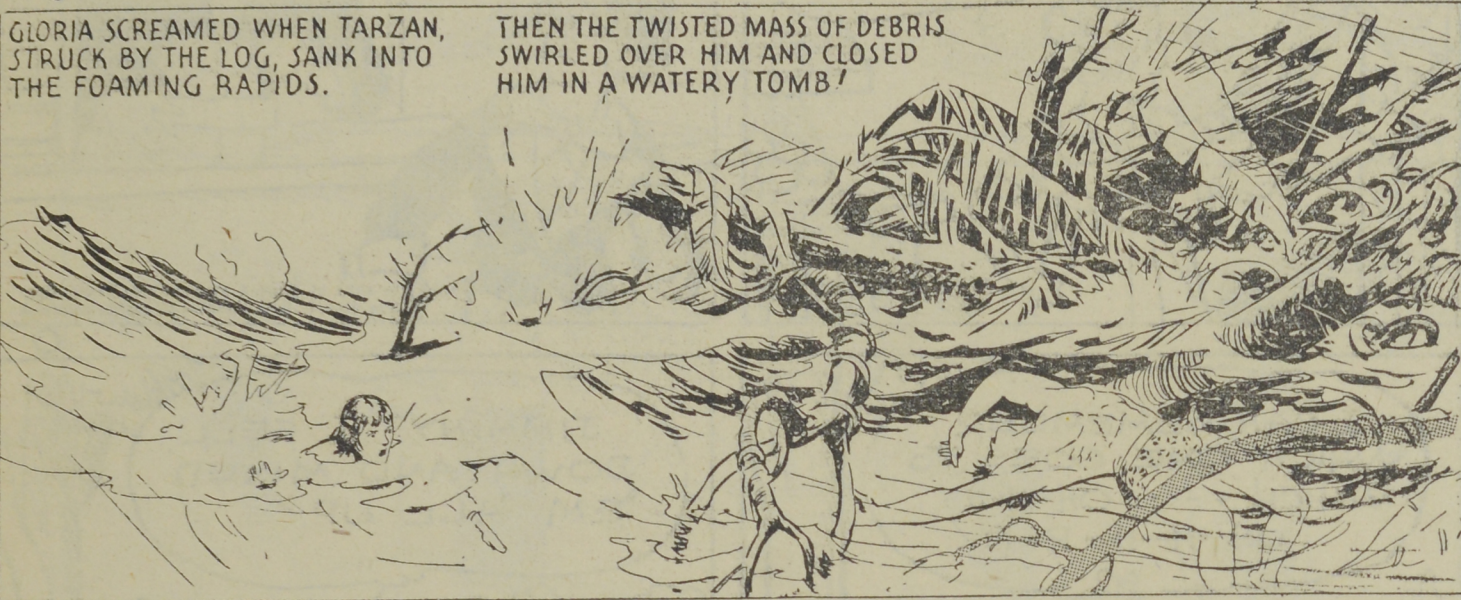

GLORIA SCREAMED WHEN TARZAN, STRUCK BY THE LOG, SANK INTO THE FOAMING RAPIDS.

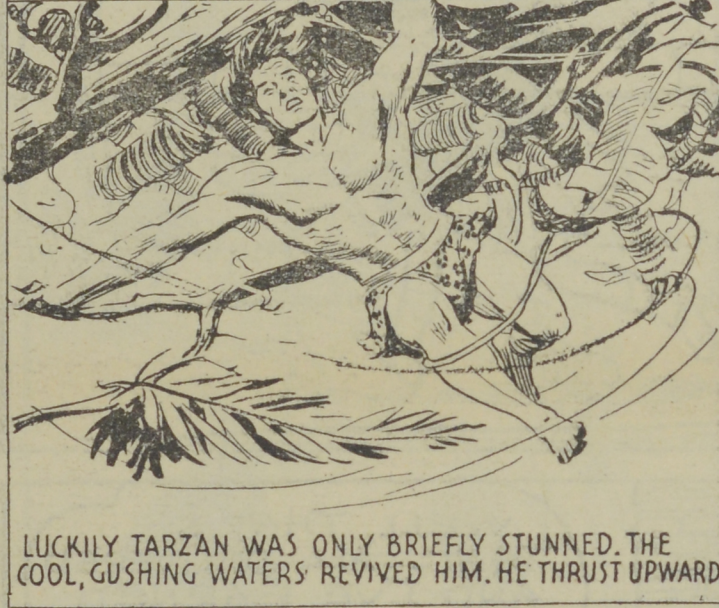
THEN THE TWISTED MASS OF DEBRIS SWIRLED OVER HIM AND CLOSED HIM IN A WATERY TOMB!



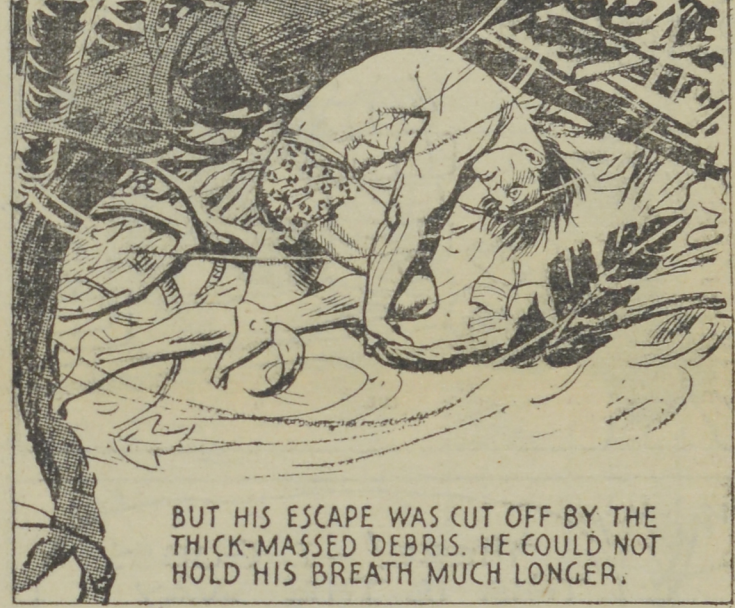
ONCE MORE, POOR GLORIA, STRUGGLING VALIANTLY, WAS SWEEPED DOWNSTREAM.



IN VAIN DICK FOUGHT TO REACH HER, KNOWING THAT WITHOUT TARZAN'S AID SHE WAS DOOMED.



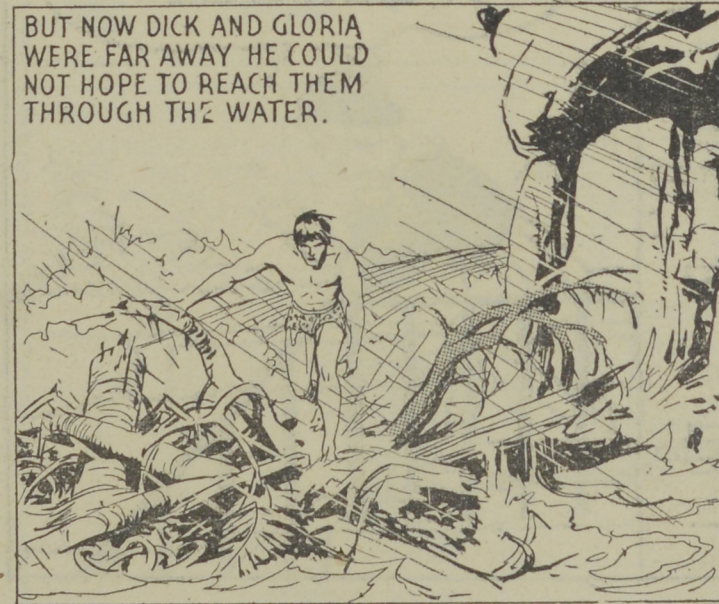

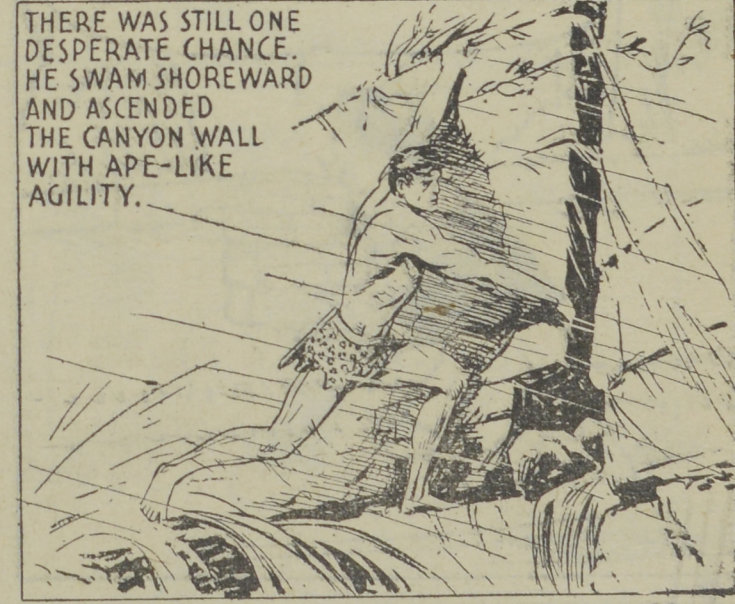
