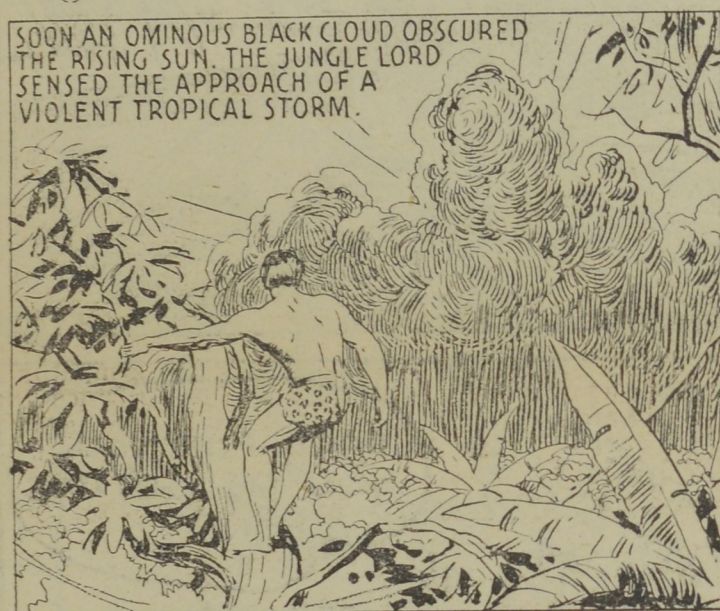
DAWN FOUND TARZAN SPEEDING THROUGH THE TREES IN PURSUIT OF GORREY'S DESPERADOES, WHO....



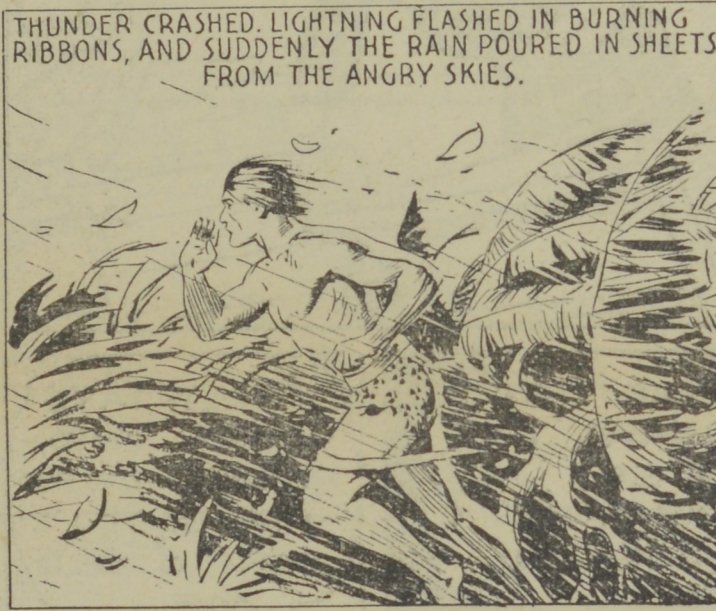
...WERE EVEN THEN EMERGING FROM THE GREAT VALLEY OF THE APES ONTO A VAST PLATEAU, WHILE.....

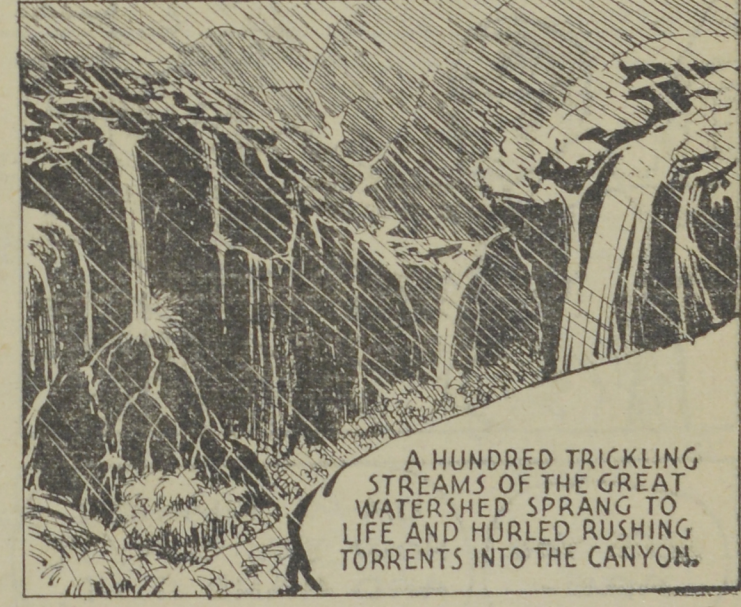

THERE, INDEED, THE STORM HAD ASSUMED THE PROPORTIONS OF A VERITABLE CLOUDBURST.



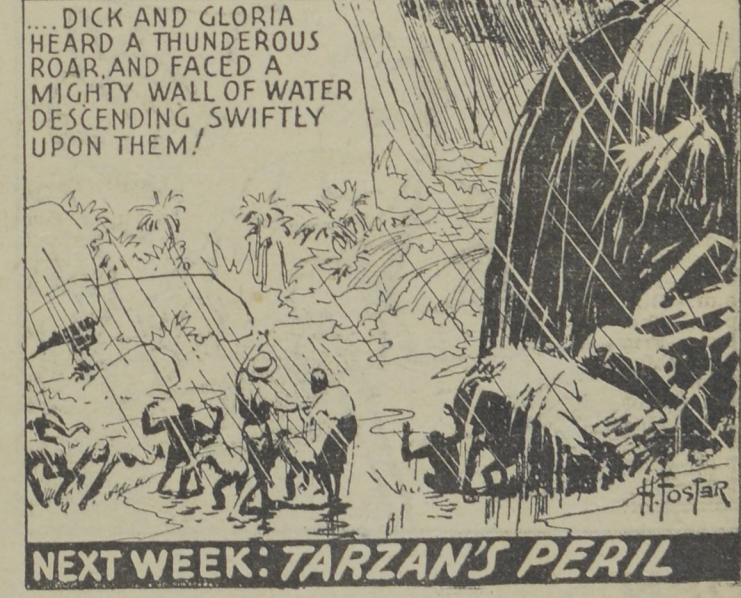
