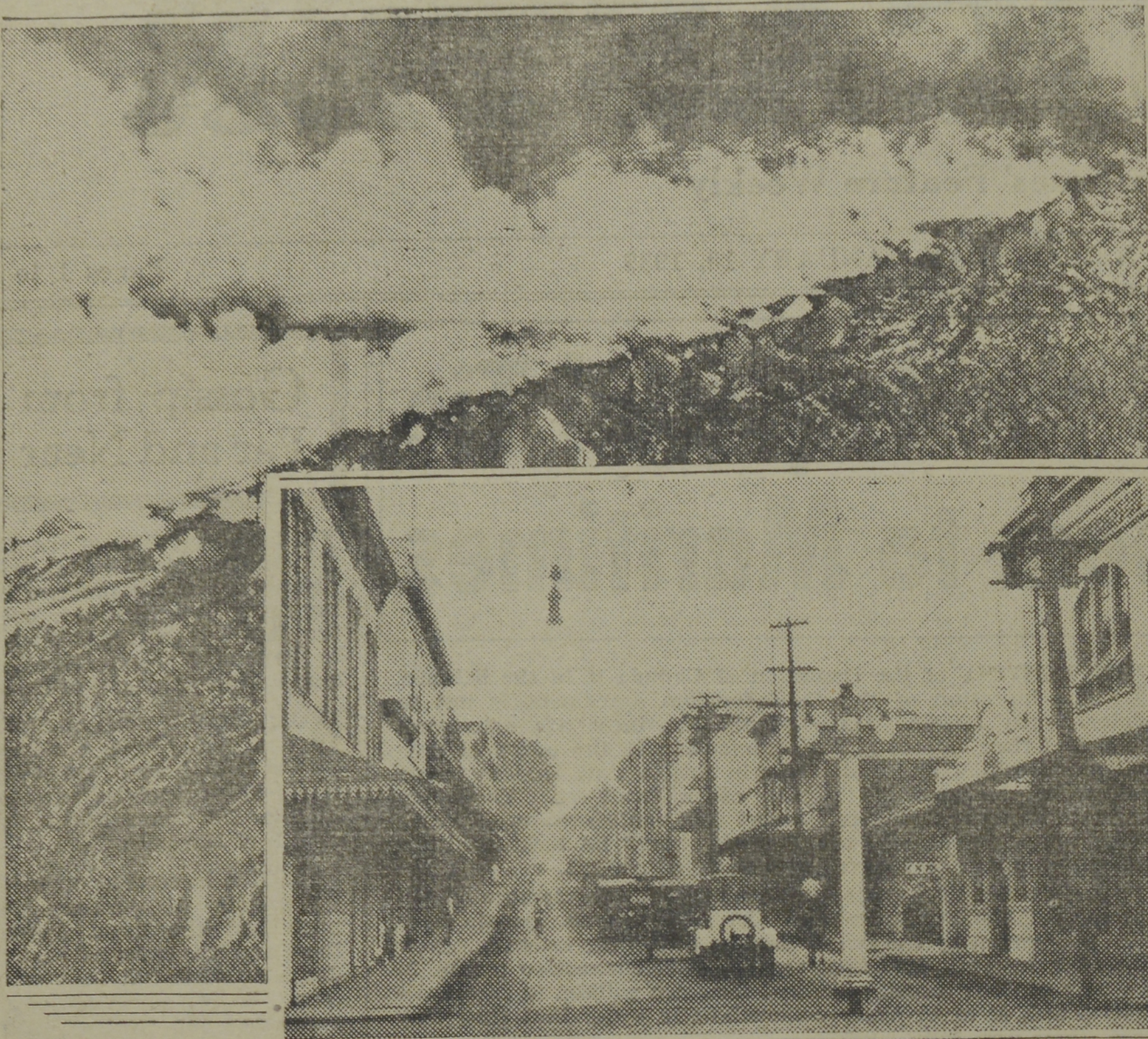


MOLTEN LAVA THREATENS HAWAIIAN CITY

Fredericton, N.B. — Announcement of the thirteenth annual short course in home economics to be conducted by the New Brunswick Department of Agriculture has been made by Hon. A. C. Taylor, Minister of the department concerned. The Agricultural School at Sussex has again been chosen as the location and dates have been set to cover the four weeks between March 3 and April 1.

The course will be under the immediate supervision of Miss

Alma Weldon, superintendent of Women's Institutes, and will be open to any woman or girl in the province. Twenty lessons will be devoted to instruction in the preparation, cooking and serving of meals properly balanced from a nutritional standpoint. There will also be instruction in elementary sewing and dressmaking, and home nursing will occupy an important place on the program.
