THE ELEMENTARY works used in the Classical Department are Ballin's Latin and Greek Grammar; Andrews's or Riddle's Latin Dictionary, and Liddell and Scott's Greek Lexicon. The Classics read are in Latin, Virgil, Horace, Livy, Cicero, Quintilian, and Tacitus; and in Greek, Dabriel's Collectanea Graeca Majora.
