Christ, Socialism and the Church

An overwhelming majority of the adult population of North America of price by profess to believe in the teachings of Jesus Christ, and most of them are actually members of some branch of the church that bears his name. But while a large and rapidly increasing number of Christians are also socialists, the church, as a body, holds aloof from the co-operative commonwealth, the officials with few, but notable, exceptions, being either indifferent or hostile, and the bulk of the membership following their natural leaders. In many quarters, where more knowledge should be expected, socialism is still looked upon as an evil and dangerous theory akin to robbery and al lied with the propaganda of the deed.

To a student of the New Testament this opposition to socialist philosophy is amazing. Now the writer does not claim that socialism and Christianity are identical. The former, as a merely economic and political faith, has nothing at all to do with religion as religion. Good socialists may be sincere Christians, Jews, Mohammedans, or Freethinkers, according to their individual preference. Other political parties are composed of persons of many different religious persuasions. So with the socialist organization. Neither does this article discuss the proper attitude of socialists towards Christianity or any other religion; but it does endeavour to show what position every true Christian should occupy in relation to the socialist party.

No follower of Jesus can consistently uphold the competitive system that present obtains. For, although Jesus founded no political party and commanded to give Caesar, or the out of socialist ideals, it logically folgovernment of the day, his due, yet no lows that the professed disciples of one can live up to the law: "Whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do even so to them," and at the same time believe in the doctrine of unlimited competition. It is simply impossible to think of the industrial rivalry of the age as being consistent with the Golden Rule. No man Christian or otherwise, likes to be crowded out of work or cheated in a property transfer; but our methods of doing things compel us to displace our competitors or be ourselves displaced. This fierce and incessant struggle, so persistent and so deadly, is the very opposite of the kingdom of God preached by the meek and lowly er's.
