The Teacher's Union.

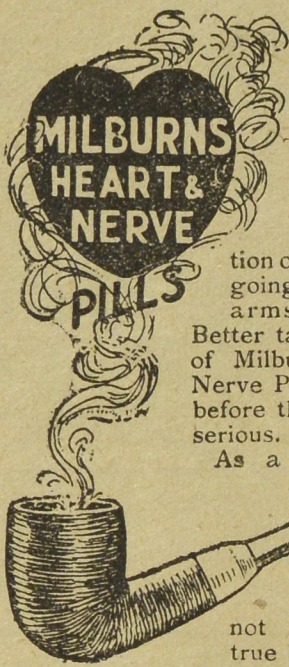
"The benefits of union to Teachers will be two-fold. First, Union will prevent a reduction of salaries, will lead to an immediate increase in many instances, and will tend to a continual increase until an equitable scale of wages is reached. Second, Union will, in bringing teachers together in one organization pledged to mutual support, increase their sympathies for each other and their interest in each others welfare, and gradually accustom them to the principles of brotherhood, which constitute the true Christianity.

Bye-and-bye, of course, the increase of salary will be more apparant than real, because, as other workers become fully organized and better paid, the cost of living to all will increase, and the net income of each individual will thereby decrease. But the remedy for this will be more union—a union of the unions—a world-wide union, that takes in every craft, every class, every nation—a union of humanity—the co-operative commonwealth, that knows no political limitations; recognizes no caste; and laughs at the patry barriers of race, language and religion that now divide mankind into so many hostile camps."—HENRY HARVEY STUART, in "A Plea for More Union," at Albert Co. Teacher's Institute, Surrey, N. B., June 4, 1903.

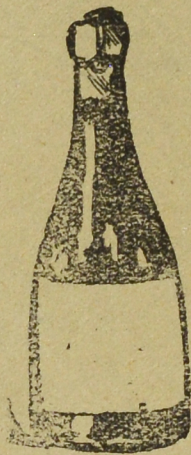
