when Britain was about to crush

Venezula but Roosevelt did not protest when Cecil Rhodes, Jo. Chamberland and their band of adventures held their pistols at the heads of the Transveal and Orange Republics, but assisted them - materially in gotting remounts and supplies. The German Kaiser, although he did not care for justice sent a cangratulatory message to Kruger, and see the resentment shown to it by the British press. If he had really been a friend of freedom he could have prevented the destruction of the South African Re publics. We would then be looking upon him with reverence and not as now with contempt.
