Curious Facts.

The rudder of the Cunard steamship
Campania consists of a single plate of
steel 22 feet long by 11 feet 8 inches wide
and, one and a quarter inches thick. It
was rolled at Krupp's gun factory Essen,
Germany.

A curious sight in the streets of Toki-
Japan, is to see an old man seated on a
peice of smooth ground, having round
him little piles of sand of different col-
ours, red, blue, yellow, black, green etc.
Placing a pinch from each pile in his
right hand, he will draw on the smooth
ground the figure of a man or woman,
the dress all properly coloured, by the
sand trickling through his fingers. It is
done with great rapidity and shows re-
markable dexterity.
