



A late copy of the Samoa Times contains the royal proclamation: "No spirituous, vinous, or fermented liquors or intoxicating drinks whatever shall be sold, given, or offered to, or bought or bartered by, any native Samoan or Pacific Islander resident in Samoa, to be taken as a beverage. Any one who will be found guilty of the violation of this provision shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$100, or by imprisonment not exceeding six months, or by both tine and imprisonment, and the liquor not yet consumed shall be confiscated."
