THE CHINESE TROUBLE.

NEW YORK, Sept. 30.—The Shanghai correspondent of the Evening Sun cables to his paper under date of the 25th, as follows: "The memorial sent to the throne by Li Hung Chang and the Viceroy of the Southern and Central provinces, asking for the denunciation of Prince Tuan, Prince Chwang and the leaders of the Boxer movement, was delayed in transmission, and was not received by Emperor Kwang-su and the Dowager Empress, who were at Tai-yuenfu until September 18.
