A Smoke-Making Shell.

New York Post: A remarkable shell of new type has been introduced into the German army, and is receiving the close attention of the British War Office. By the introduction of a Cartridge composed of amorphous phosphorus into an ordinary charge of smokeless powder, thick, white smoke is emitted when the shell bursts, thus showing the gunners, even at the greatest distance, how close the projectile has gone to the enemy's position. By increasing the propor tion of this chemical operation, which will not lessen the bursting effect, it has been found possible to deposit in front of an enemy's position a thick bank of white smoke, which for many seconds, will alto-gether obliterate his view of the field.






