Discovery Of Gold In California.

The discovery of gold in California was purely accidental. In September 1847, Capt. Sutter, a famous pioneer, contracted with James W. Marshall to construct a sawmill at Colona. In the course of the winter a dam and race were made but when the water was let on the tailrace was found to be too narrow. To widen and deepen it, Marshall let a strong current of water directly into the race, with the result that that a quantity of sand and gravel was borne to the foot. On January 19, 1848, Marshall observed some glittering particles in the race, and was curious enough to examine them. He called some carpenters who were at work on the mill; but, though the possibility that the substance was gold was discussed, the prospect did not inflame any of them, and it was some time before the full importance of the discovery was realized even by those in the neighborhood. Then all other work was suspended; thousands of eager fortune hunters from all over the world made the long journey across the plains or by way of the Isthmus or Cape Horn; territory that for generations would have remained untenanted, was filled with settlers' and two years later California admitted to Statehood.

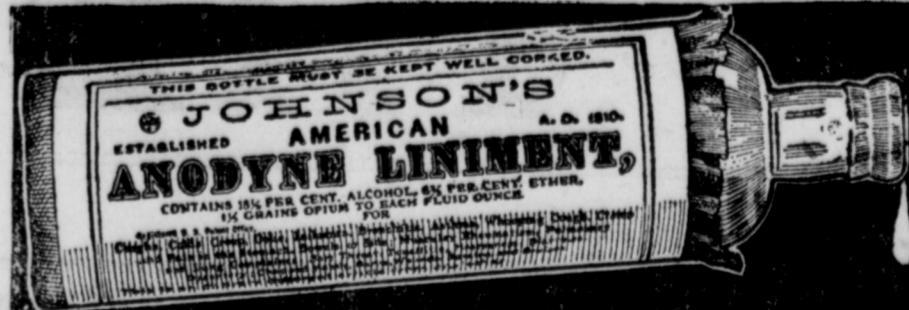
