### The Real Significance of the Niobe

Now that the Niobe has reached her marine home in Canadian waters there can be no doubt that this fine protected cruiser is a warship to be proud of. All disparaging epithets may as well be dropped, and all deprecatory criticisms may as well cease; neither of them can obscure the obvious fact that the Niobe is well equipped for fighting and can reach a high rate of speed. She is admirably adapted for the very service she would be expected to render if Canada were ever to find her commerce threatened with destruction by the cruisers of a nation at war with Great Britain. She would then be in fact what she is at present in theory; a protector of Canadian commerce. This is the effective answer to those who would prefer paying to Great Britain the price of one or more Dreadnoughts. In a naval war with a European power the Dreadnoughts would be needed in the North Sea and the English Channel, and there will always be enough of them there to serve the purpose for which they are built. What we may need and will have for Canada is strong, fast cruisers which can out sail and out fight ordinary commerce destroyers on the high seas.—Toronto Globe.

### Truro Presbytery First to Decide For Church Union.

Truro, N. S., Oct. 25.—A meeting of the Presbytery of Truro was held today. The chief business was a consideration of remits from the general assembly, the principal item of which was the basis of union with the Methodists and Congregationalists. Most of the day was spent on this remit, practically every member speaking on the question. When the vote was taken it stood thirteen to one in favor of the basis of union.

The Presbytery of Truro is the oldest in the dominion, and so far as known is the first to come to a decision on this matter.

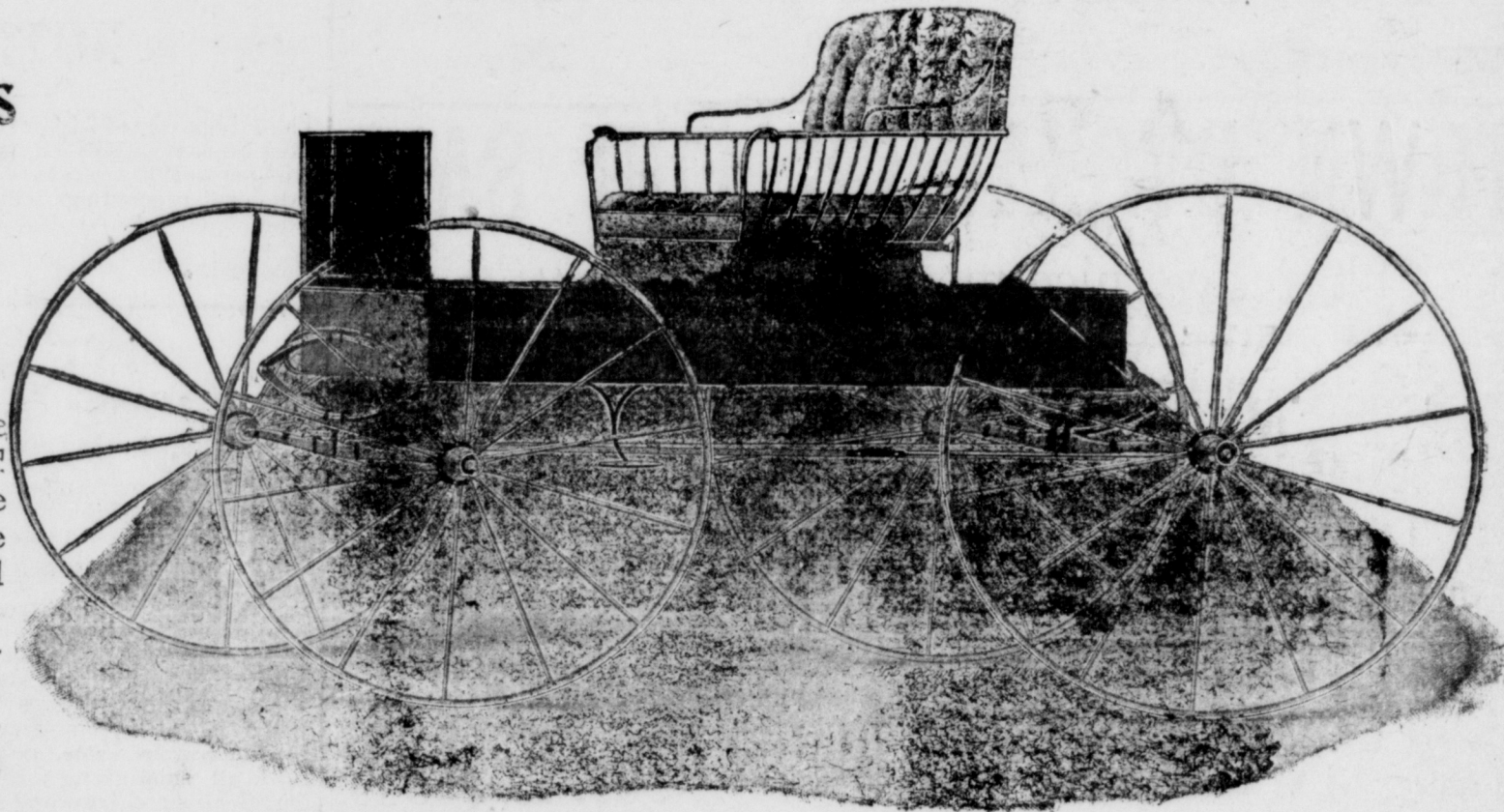
### A REPUBLIC IN PORTUGAL

A rebellion having for its object the overthrow of the monarchy and the establishment of a republic broke out at Lisbon, October 4th. Several regiments of troops and the war ships in the harbor took sides with the revolutionists, and there was severe fighting in the streets. King Manuel, with his mother and grandmother, fled from the palace, and later found refuge at Gibraltar. October 5th a provisional government was proclaimed, with Theophilo Braga as president. [October 6th the republic was proclaimed at Oporto Braga and other places; and its establishment appears to have been pretty generally acquiesced in throughout the country.—The Youth's Companion
