

Death of Judge Gregory

Hon George F Gregory, retired member of the Supreme Court bench, passed away about seven o'clock Saturday morning from the efficites of several paralytic strokes which have impaired bis hea'th for several years past and caused his retirement from the barc's several years ago.

The late Judge Gregory was a son of John Gregory, of Edinburgh, and Mary Grosvenor, who came out from Scotland in 1820. He was born at Fredericton on August 31st, 1839, and was educated at the Fredericten Collegiste School and King's College, now the U. N. B. He studied law with the late Hon J J Fraser, and was admitted to the bar in 1863 and pracised for twenty-two years in partnership with the late Hon A G Blair, afterwards by himself and later with his brother, Mr A J Gregory, K C. He was created a Queen's Counsel in 1891.

In 1897 he was appointed to the Supreme Court bench and retired on account of ill health in 1909.

The late Judge Gregory was Mayor of Fredericton from 1869 to 1873, and again from 1878 to 1880.

In politics, deceased was a Liberal, and he contested York County as candidate for the House of Commons against the late Hon Thomas Temple in 1884, and was defeated, and also contested the same seat unsuccessfully again against the same candidate in 1887.

In 1890 he was an unsuccessful candidate for the Legislative Assembly, and was | again defeated in the bye-election which followed the resignation of the local government candidates.

For many years he was a member of St Paul's Presbytanian church and chairman of its trustee board, but of late years he had been a member of Christ Church Cathedral (Anglican) congregation.

He was twice married, first to Marion, daughter of the late Francis Beverly in 1860. She died in 1871 and he married Isabe la, widow of the late Stephen Whittaker. She died some years ago.
