Bridgeport Conn. Mar 28—Mrs Fanny Crosby, the noted hymn writer, whose ninety first birthday anniversary last week found her as youthful in spirit as a school girl, was the guest of **Fanny Crosby Circle King's Daughters**, at a luncheon in honor of

the event. **Miss Crosby** displayed her accustomed vivacity as she responded to her well wishers interspersing her remarks with timely poetic thoughts and witty observations.

Miss Crosby was entertained in the evening by intimate friends at the home of **Dr Edward S Smith**. In response to a toast she said;

Friends, the angel of the hour is holding to my lips a chalice so full of blessings that I am lost in its infinity, and as I listen He reminds me that twelve golden mouths have borne to the divine Author of my being the record of another year. Think of it, the record of another year.

The Lord has done great things for me, whereof I am glad. He has preserved my health, my strength my intellect. He has renewed the vigor of my youth. I ought to be the happiest mortal in the world, and I guess I am. Nothing troubles me. I praise His name. I can trust Him all that is to come.

MILITARY DRILL AND PHYSICAL TRAINING.

Judging by the numerous enquiries received by the **Local Secretary of the Summer School of Science at Fredericton**, respecting the courses to be given in these two subjects during the coming summer, it appears that some confusion exists in the minds of many teachers with regard to them.

The course in **Military Drill** is for male only, and is open to prospective teachers who wish to qualify for the organization and instruction of cadet corps. The course lasts six weeks, and takes up the whole time of those who enter upon it.

The courses in **Physical Training** are open to teachers of both sexes, and consist approximately of thirty lessons of one hour each, usually spread over three weeks. At the conclusion of the course, a certificate is granted by the **Militia Department**. The **Chief Superintendent of Education** announces that in order to obtain a teacher's license in this Province, it is now necessary to have this certificate. Also that after the end of the present year, all teachers must possess it to obtain advance of class, and further, that at the end of four years from the same date, all schools must provide **Physical Training** by qualified instructors.

The **Summer School of Science** affords an excellent opportunity for teachers to obtain this certificate, and at the same time to qualify for better positions in their profession by improving themselves in other subjects by means of the classes in **Science, Nature Study, Drawing Literature, Hand work, etc.**, from July 13 to August 2, in **Fredericton**.

Application for admission to the course in **Military Drill** must be made to the **Chief Superintendent of Education**, and for the **Summer School of Science** to the **Local Secretary, Fredericton**.

Douglas Mawson has entered a protest against **Captain Scott** landing his party at **Cape Adare**. He refers to the agreement between himself and **Scott** made last year, but even on **Mawson's** own showing, **Scott** was apparently only restricted from scientific work along the coast between **Cape Adare** and **Gussberg**, and selecting that district as a starting point for the dash to the **Pole**.

TACOMA WOMEN'S VOTES GET A LAW AGAINST TREATING.

Tacoma, Wash., Mar 25—The women of Tacoma in their first test at the polls in the city's history, came out strongly against the saloon element, according to this week's returns from the referendum election. It was the first referendum vote under the new city charter.

By a substantial majority the women secured the adoption of an anti treating ordinance making it illegal for saloon keepers to accept money from any person treating another.

This result shows that women hold the balance of power in Tacoma. Of 21,587 voters who registered for the election 65 per cent voted and of these approximately 5000 were women. Ninety per cent of the women voted for the anti treating ordinance.

Washington, March 28—President Taft's message to the extra congress to be convened next Tuesday will be exceptionally brief. He has decided to deal only with the reciprocity agreement with Canada. Later the president may send another message to the extra session urging the enactment of a law making the tariff board a permanent institution. The president has been assured by the temporary board that it will be ready with a detailed and comprehensive report on the textile schedules by Dec. 1 next, and that the chemical schedules may also be ready.

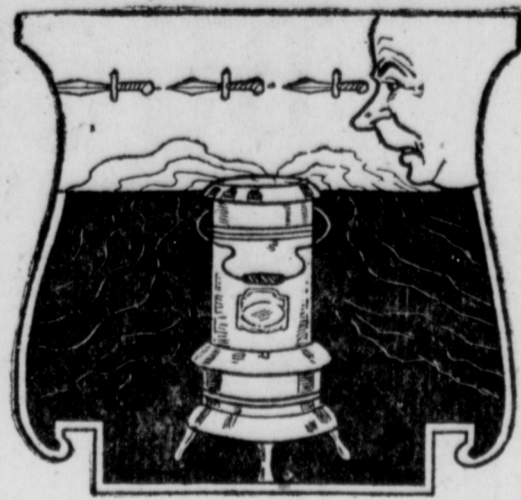
